Lay Day Fluke & Sea Bass Tournament

Rules and Regulations

Lay Day departure and return times are on the honor system and this is a gentlemen's tournament, protests will not be accepted on the Lay Day Fluke or Sea Bass Tournament issues.

The four day format for 2022 will allow for the option to Fluke and Sea Bass on both of the designated lay days.

The start time of the Lay Day Fluke tournament is 8:00 AM. You may **not leave New Harbor Block Island breakwater prior to 8:00 AM** on your designated Lay Day.

The end time of the Lay Day Fluke tournament is 2:30 PM. The boat must be **inside the New Harbor Block Island breakwater by 2:30 PM** on your designated Lay Day to weigh an eligible Fluke or Sea Bass.

Lay Day departure and return times are on the honor system and this is a gentlemen's tournament, protests will not be accepted on the Lay Day Fluke or Sea Bass Tournament issues.

The winning fish are by weight, and standard angling rules apply

Only one Fluke and one Sea Bass will be counted from each boat entered in the Tournament.

The boat that is used during the Lay Day Fluke Tournament does not have to be the boat listed on the Tri-State roster.

Registered boats and crews that have multiple boats can not fish two boats on the same day for the same or multiple categories or sub tournaments.

The fluke/ sea bass must be weighed in by a registered angler; however it may be caught by friends or family aboard the designated Fluke Tournament boat.
